The property is flat, rectangular in shape, has about 90 FT of prime frontage along the Highway 97/Main St corridor and has a depth of about 180 FT. There is a stand-alone, multi-unit commercial building on the street-front of approximately 4,012 SF. This is an ideal opportunity for an owner-occupier, one who have interest in occupying a unit while holding onto a tenant to add a component of income to the purchasing equation. Paved parking area to the side and rear of the building. Zoned C1 - Medium Density Commercial Zone allowing a wide variety of primary uses. There is redevelopment potential with a current FAR of .25, while C1 zoning allows a FAR of 1.5, a maximum height of up to 4 storeys and a site coverage of 100%. West Kelowna has established plans for the revitalization of Westbank's commercial core making this property a good candidate for potential redevelopment or assembly with neighbouring properties.
